Dear Campbell Families,

Welcome to the 2019-2020 School Year! Can you believe that the first day of school is just two weeks away? I am excited and overjoyed to welcome you to the start of a great year. When you arrive at Campbell for Back to School Night on August 12th, you will see that many things have stayed the same while others have changed. Some noticeable changes are new teammates that we have joining us. You can see their names and positions to the left. We are so lucky to have these individuals becoming a part of our community. One thing that has not changed is our guarantee that **all** Campbell students learn to their fullest potential. This promise is one reason that Campbell is both a state and nationally recognized school for student and adult learning. Another adjustment is this year we will have two multi-grades with combined 1st/2nd & 4th/5th grade classrooms. Multi-grades allow us to keep class sizes small and to differentiate students learning at an extremely high level. This differentiation is part of why Campbell received the Governor's Distinguished Improvement award last year.

Online Registration began Monday, July 29th. All families must complete the registration process for every Campbell student at the start of each year. This provides an opportunity for families to update contact information, sign agreements, pay school fees, complete Free & Reduced lunch applications and submit requested forms. Check the [Registration](#) website for an active link to begin the process. Teacher assignments for students will be emailed the afternoon of August 9th to the primary email address provided when registering. If you have yet to update Jeffco Connect, you will want to do so quickly.

The first day of school is August 14th. The building opens at 7:30am with school starting at 7:45am. For the most up to date calendar, please refer to the [Calendars](#) page on our website. We have student supervision 15 minutes before the first bell rings. All students can enter the front door of the building where we have staff to welcome all kids for their day. We encourage using the front doors for our youngest learners as teachers can assist them to making their way to classrooms. Knowing that many parents are rushing on their way to work, our Hug and Go lane is designed precisely for that purpose. If you are planning on staying, or need more time to say goodbye, we encourage you to use the parking lot.

Other important dates to note include our first Assessment by Appointment day on August 23rd. Assessment days are used by the Campbell staff to assess students in a small group setting to determine their specific needs and strengths. We use these assessments to provide the best possible instruction throughout the school year. On Assessment Days, students only report to school during their pre-arranged time. You will receive an invitation from your classroom teacher on August 16th to select the most convenient time slot for your family. Also, we will be having Field Day in the fall again this year to allow for better weather and less conflicts with spring activities. Make sure to block off October 4th if you are interested in attending.

- **Supply Lists:** Supply lists for all grades are located on our school website. www.campbellelementary.org. You can also find a link on our website to easily report absences from your phone or computer.
- **Breakfast & Lunch:** Campbell begins serving breakfast at 7:30am with a \$2.00 cost. Lunch cost has increased to \$3.25.
- **Free & Reduced Lunch Application:** Part of the registration process includes completing a F&R lunch application. We realize that many families will be bringing their lunches all year and never utilize our cafeteria services. We do ask, however, that **every** family complete the application, even if you do not believe you will qualify nor take advantage of the resource. The reason for this is that the state of Colorado provides funding to schools based on this information. By just completing the application, you can help ensure that funds from the State will come directly to our school and enhance your child's educational endeavors at Campbell. Campbell students deserve these financial resources which will not be allocated without our community taking the time to complete the form.
