The week after conferences, our first session of Cougar Clubs will begin. Cougar Clubs is our after-school enrichment program that runs three times a year. Also this month, we will be hosting the Campbell Ghost Chase. The Ghost Chase is Campbell's 1-mile cross country race that is open to all students in the 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Even if you do not have a runner, this is a great opportunity to get out and celebrate the kids in our community for their tremendous effort. If students are not able to run in the Ghost Chase, they can also participate in Mileage Club, which will begin this month. Mileage Club takes place twice a week during lunch recess. Students run and keep track of their laps and miles with the support of parent volunteers. They can earn a variety of prizes depending on how many miles they run this year. Mileage club is a great way to come and volunteer at Campbell. Each shift lasts less than one hour and you can bring younger siblings with while you help out. Other ways to volunteer at Campbell include our Watch DOG program, which is open to all fathers and father figures to come spend a day working alongside students while they are learning. And teachers also are looking for consistent volunteers to run reading and enrichment groups weekly. We want all our families to know they are welcome at Campbell Elementary. Even if you are unable to volunteer at the school, working with your student(s) at home is the most important way to guarantee their academic success.
