Wow was April wild! With so many great events to enrich our students, we hope you were able to participate in some or all.

This month the action continues with Field Day, field trips, Race to Read and a musical performance. We also will have our last modified contact days of the year on May 4<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>. A reminder that students only attend school on these days during their pre-scheduled time for testing. This year's teachers will use results to determine our effectiveness and if we need to make any refinements to our lessons. Next year's teachers will use the results to align instruction to meet our mission to ensure that all kids learn to their fullest potential from the first day of school.

This month, we will also be honoring Mrs. Madeline Archuleta who will be retiring at the end of the year. We will be holding a retirement celebration the afternoon of May 15<sup>th</sup>. All students and families, past & present are invited. We are hoping you will attend and relay the date & time to former students and families you have contact with. In addition to Mrs. Archuleta's retirement, other staff changes next year include Ms. Jeany Frederickson who has officially been hired as Campbell's Kitchen Manager. Ms. Frederickson has been serving our students for the majority of the year and will stay on as part of the Campbell community moving forward. Make sure to encourage your children to celebrate her.

Other changes you will see next year will be in regards to classroom location. As we continue to strive to meet our mission and with the transition of 6<sup>th</sup> grade to middle school, many of our classrooms will be in a new location. The current 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> grade (South) hallway will house our Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, and 2<sup>nd</sup> grades next year, whereas the North hallway will be filled with 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, and 5<sup>th</sup> grade classrooms. The decision to place classrooms with similar grades in proximity will allow for us to continue to share students among multiple teaching staff and provide just the right instruction to each student. Additionally, families of our youngest students will be closest to the hug & go zone, office, and entry doors ensuring the safety of all children.

The last day of school in May 24<sup>th</sup> with a noon dismissal. We will have award ceremonies that morning and you are welcome to check your student out immediately after the ceremony by signing them out in the main office. All students do need to be signed out they are leaving before noon.
